GRADING AND CREDITS

All student work will be graded according to district grading practices, and high school students will earn credits toward graduation.

AT-HOME DAYS

Student participation is expected on a daily basis. Teachers will provide "live" instruction using Google Meet at regularly scheduled times. Student assignments will be provided in Google Classroom and all Google Meets will be recorded and posted to Google Classroom for access by students at any time based on family schedule. Contact between teachers and students will be maintained via Google Meet, District Gmail, Google Hangout Phone, or Google Chat.



Classroom Setup on Onsite Days

With fewer students in the classroom, children will be assigned designated seats, with appropriate space between, and barriers available.

School Bus Transportation

Families will have access to the bus stop schedule before the start of the school year. With less than 50% capacity, social distancing will be practiced. Students are expected to wear face coverings/masks and to use the hand sanitizer on the bus upon boarding. Children should be screened at home for a temperature and other symptoms before boarding the bus.

Extracurricular Activities

In the Hybrid Phase, students are able to participate in extracurricular activities. Coaches and sponsors will provide specific schedule information to students.

Childcare Options Before and After School and on "At-Home" Learning Days

HEALTH AND SAFETY



Hand sanitizer will be readily available along with hand washing opportunities throughout the school day.

Face Coverings/Masks: Staff and Students will be expected to wear cloth or disposable face coverings/masks when social distancing is difficult or not possible, and highly encouraged to wear cloth or disposable face coverings/masks at all times when on school district premises. The school district will have at least one reusable and washable cloth face covering for each student. In addition, there will be disposable face coverings available.
