Dear Parents & Guardians of Grades 6 - 12 Students,

During the prescribed break, your students have the opportunity to access and use some special “Learning Opportunity” versions of online courses created by an academic online course company named Edgenuity and customized by our district curriculum specialists to align with our district’s course curriculum maps.

We have used Edgenuity courses in our district in various ways for the past eight years.

Your student should be able to launch Edgenuity via the ClassLink page/menu on their Chromebook.

If they aren’t able to do that, they can launch it via their Edgenuity system by typing the following web address into the address space of the Chrome web browser on their Chromebook and pressing [enter] on the keyboard.

**Password:** **cb123456** where 123456 is your student’s Council Bluffs Schools student ID number.

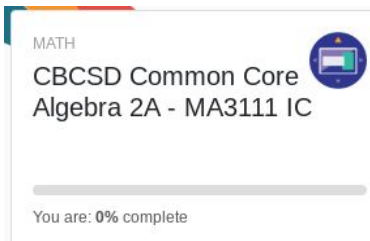
So, if, for example, Lonny Learner’s Council Bluffs Schools student ID is 654321

Click the  button.

Once signed into Edgenuity, an “Introduction to Edgenuity” video will play to provide an overview of the look and feel of courses.

On their desktop, they will see a rectangle for each of the courses in which they have been enrolled.

For example, if one the courses in which they have been enrolled is **[CBCSD Common Core Algebra 2A - MA3111]** they will see this.



To enter the course, they simply click on the course title, **[CBCSD Common Core Algebra 2A - MA3111]**

The “Learning Opportunity” course versions in which your student is enrolled have been modified to provide them the opportunity to continue learning during the break.
