

Criteria For Selection of Thomas Jefferson Hall of Fame Inductee

1. Financial status alone shall not be the reason for choice.
2. The nominee's (life) and career is of benefit to many. This can be through education, research, arts & music, athletics, and service to community.
3. Nominees can be alumnus, or served the school as faculty, administration or staff; living or dead. Alumni nominees will generally be from classes that graduated at least ten years earlier. This is a guideline that the committee may override if the consensus of the group is that the nominee and their accomplishment/contributions are so outstanding as to deserve recognition within 10 years of graduation from high school.
4. All recommendations not selected will be held for review the following year.

Guidelines

1. The Hall of Fame Committee will gather candidates for selection twelve-months in advance.
2. Nominees will be advised at least six months in advance of the Induction
3. Inductees will be introduced and asked to address the Thomas Jefferson student body at an assembly during the school day.
4. Inductees will have the opportunity to visit classrooms and take a tour of the school prior to the luncheon.
